Role of the Month – GENERAL EVALUATOR

Taking on this role improves critical thinking, organization, time management, motivational and team-building skills.

The General Evaluator evaluates everything that takes place during the club meeting. In addition, the General Evaluator conducts the evaluation portion of the meeting and is responsible for the evaluation team: the speech evaluators, Ah Counter, Grammarian and Timer. As General Evaluator, you:

- Identify and confirm meeting assignments with the Timer, Grammarian, and Ah-Counter.
- Contact your team several days before the meeting to ensure they each know their tasks and responsibilities.
- Recruit members to fill vacant roles on your team before or at the meeting.
- Explain the purpose and benefits of evaluations to the group.
- Confirm the club meeting program and/or checklist with the Toastmaster.
- During the meeting, take notes and report on all club proceedings to evaluate things such as timeliness, enthusiasm, preparation, organization, performance of duties, etc., and make any suggestions for improvement.

Table Topics Tip

Go with the first little idea that comes into your head. Sooner or later, a little idea will pop into your head. Even if it's just a little idea, start talking about it. Don't reject it in the hope that a bigger idea will come along: The little idea must be expressed first. If you reject it, it will sulk and block the bigger idea from ever getting through.

Agenda Rules Reminder

- 1. Are you getting close to finishing your Competent Leader Manual, Competent Communicator Manual, or a *Pathways Level?* Once you have only one project or functionary role remaining to complete your manual or level, contact <u>Katie Honecker Stephens</u>, CL, *before* an agenda opens to find out if you can have priority for the needed role on that agenda.
- 2. Does your next project include a speech that is longer than 10 minutes? Let Katie Honecker Stephens, CL, know

before you sign up, so she can remove one of the speaker slots to keep our meeting timely.

3. *Ever wonder if there's a preferred speaking order?* There is. The preferred order is to have members with less experience (e.g., ice breaker) speak before members with more experience, based on the number of speeches they have given in Toastmasters. Please keep this desired order in mind when you sign up. The Toastmaster-of-the-Day or an officer may rearrange the agenda's speaking order if speakers sign up out of order.
